

REHEARSAL GUIDELINES FOR HAWAII COMMUNITY CHORUS REGARDING COVID 19.

Guidelines can be revisited as the situation including the chorus's sound warrants.

Performance guidelines present additional issues and will be developed in collaboration with the Artistic Director well before a performance date is selected.

- 1) Masks are optional. For those who wish to wear a mask, the chorus encourages the use of a clear plastic singer's mask. The chorus will provide one to any singer.
- 2) As has been suggested by the State of Hawaii and the Department of Health, it is highly recommended that singers be up to date on their vaccinations.
- 3) Singers should spread out at least an arm's length apart in their parts in rows. In deference to members who feel they need additional space, they can use the last four rows, with a row between each populated row. During rehearsals, singers have the right to space themselves as they feel necessary.
- 4) No singer should attend a rehearsal if s/he is sick. This applies whether the singer has a cold or the flu or any other communicable illness.
- 5) If a singer tests positive, he or she should notify the Board via email at hilocommunitychorusboard@gmail.com; the Board (or designated committee chair) will notify the chorus using the same email.
- 6) Prior to returning to the chorus, a singer who has tested positive for covid should have two negative test results 48 hours apart.
